Key Responsibilities

- Operate all machines in the Fabrication Department in an effective and cost efficient manner while maintaining good quality and safety standards.
- o Check samples periodically and ensure they match first piece sample check.
- o Ensure first piece sample is double checked by other plant personnel.
- o Ensure material is identified for shape number, work order number and quantity. If material is being used from stock, have stock number identified on work order.

- o Ensure material is checked for proper cut length before fabrication.
- o Responsible for reporting equipment malfunction.
- o On-time order completion.
- o Comply with all quality related policies, procedures and system requirements.
- o All other activities as assigned.
