JOB DESCRIPTION

Directly responsible to the Press Supervisor. Must respond to requests from all plant personnel when the need arises. Functionally responsible for safe handling and storage of material and the safe operation of a forklift.

Key Responsibilities

- Ensure forklift is in good working condition.
- Do forklift maintenance checks each day before start-up.
- Ensure press does not have to wait for billets/logs.
- Ensure that the crew is fully supplied with their proper supplies ie: separators, cardboard, wood and back-up skids

- Ensure material is tagged with work order number, die number, number of pieces and temper and that load is free from sawdust before transporting from production saw area to the next stage (age ovens)
- Ensure all aluminum scrap bins at saw locations and presses are emptied half hour before end of each shift.
- Stack material without causing damage to the load below it.
- Ensure all age ovens are loaded and unloaded in a timely manner.
- Use the computer to enter all info into Epics when tempering (must be entered correctly and under the proper oven).
- Ensure all paper work is complete and follows the material to the next stage.
- Comply with all quality related policies, procedures and system requirements

DESIRED SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE

Experience

- Candidates should have a minimum of 1 year experience in forklift operation.
- Must be able to read and write English and be familiar with weights and measurements.
- Basic computer skills required.
- Must have training in forklift driving and its safe operation through a recognized institute.
- Must have valid forklift license.
- A solid understanding of the following equipment/technology; forklift, snips, slings, tape measure, weighting scale, overhead cranes, dollies, chains, computers

- Minimum of grade 8 education
